

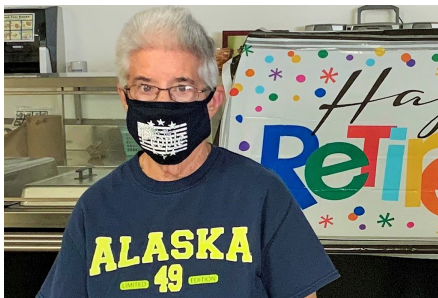

A: Right now, we've been doing Zoom meetings and watch parties through the Anthesis IECBS Facebook page that have been teaching me with how to be independent.

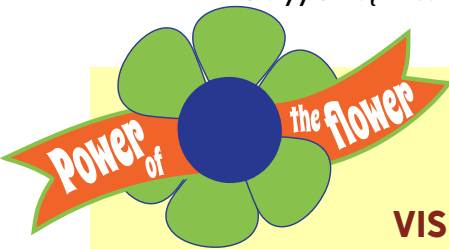
Q: In your own words, what does Anthesis mean to you?
