In July 2019, Chris was authorized for our Discovery program and began applying at various businesses. One of the first places he applied was the Bass Pro Shop. Even though he was not hired, the search continued. Chris joined a boxing gym and will tell you that boxing has been a goal his entire life. He never thought he would have a chance to join a gym, much less a boxing club. Chris now boxes every Tuesday as part of the IECBS program. He applied for a position at the Self Care Lab where he boxes. He landed what he will tell you is his "dream job". He is now the Equipment Manager at Self Care Labs and is responsible for the maintenance of the facility. His goal is to be in an amateur boxing match. Congratulations on your new position, Chris!
